

This Public Hearing is being convened so that Council can hear the views of the public with respect to the subject bylaw(s). Council members may ask questions of the proponent or City staff. Council may not debate the merits of the proposed bylaw(s) with individual citizens.

At this Public Hearing, any person present who believes that his or her interests are affected by the proposal shall be given an opportunity to be heard. However, it is important that all who speak at this meeting restrict their remarks to matters contained within the bylaw(s). No one will be or, should feel, discouraged or prevented from making his or her views known.

Those of you who wish to speak concerning the proposed bylaw(s) will be given the opportunity.

The Chair will:

- Ask for Verbal Gallery submissions
*If you wish to speak, come up to the presentation desk, push the microphone button, state your full name and address for the record, proceed with your submission.
 - Ask for a second round of Verbal Gallery submissions
 - Third and final call for submissions
