Note: 20 residents (11 Quesnel and 9 CRD) wanted the stage tech to remain as-is.

- An additional 6 residents stated that they are afraid the equipment would be damaged.
- An additional 4 residents voted a general "yes", if there would be security measures to keep equipment safe.



Q5 ROTARY BALL PARK – The Rotary Ball Park is used for only 2 to 3 months each year, requiring significant maintenance during that time period. The City and Cariboo Regional District have been working to build two premier ball parks located at West Fraser Park and Barlow Creek. If additional funding could be directed to those two parks, additional amenities such as lighting to extend the season could be considered. Is the ball park the best use for this space in LeBourdais Park?
