FLP AS OPPORTUNITY

- PERSTANDING OUR FIRM
- Nazko views the FLP process as the best
 opportunity to engage in collaborative long-term
 planning for the resiliency of this land base.
- Every Nation involved stands to benefit from the informed and shared decision-making the FLP process presents, **regardless of their territorial assertions**.

PARTICIPATION IN FLP

- The FLP process is an important **planning** process that requires technical expertise and a commitment to come to the table prepared, informed, and able to keep the process moving forward.
- This is a big commitment on Nazko's part that has been generally **under-resourced.**

COMMITMENT TO FLP

- Our technical team has been highly engaged.
- We have undertaken community visioning exercises for our land and the values from this are being brought to the FLP table.
- Chief and Council are now engaging more fully so we can play our role at the Leadership Table.

WHY IS NAZKO ENGAGED?

- Out of respect for our elders so their wisdom and knowledge can be incorporated into future plans.
- For our children and their children's children this is our best opportunity to plan together with their future in mind.
- The FLP process involves First Nations at the table we do not want to go back to fighting unilateral decision-making by the "Crown."

WHAT'S REQUIRED FOR SUCCESS?

- All First Nations see the inherent value in this process as a collaborative planning exercise.
- All participants come to the table **informed** and able to keep the dialogue **focussed and progressing**.
- The Province **resources the table fully**: support for First Nations' technical teams, data collection, modelling, community engagement, and collaborative leadership discussions.

BEYOND THE PLAN!

 The success of this plan depends on the ongoing of First Nations in its <u>implementation</u>.

• So, all <u>First Nations must be fully resourced</u> to monitor the implementation of the operating plan that we collectively develop for the Quesnel Forest District.
