- Several years' experience and demonstrated skill in reading and following construction plans and blue prints
- Advanced understanding of all types of construction and concrete framing
- Possess a valid Class 5 BC Driver's License.

Skills and Abilities:

- The successful applicant must possess the physical ability to carry out his/her designated duties
- Proven ability to competently direct personnel
- A self starter with the ability to work effectively on your own and with a team
- Ability to communicate effectively, orally and written, in English with other employees, supervisors and the general public
- Knowledge of proper sidewalk cross slopes and acceptable tolerances for sidewalks
- Know how to form and finish sidewalks, walls, footers, grade beams etc.
