HEALTH AND SAFETY PROGRAMS

PREVENTING DISEASE TRANSMISSION AND OPIOID POISONING AWARENESS WORKSHOP | Ages 12yrs+

Preventing Disease Transmission is a course that shares knowledge on how infections occur and how they can be prevented with a strong focus on how to use PPE correctly. The workshop is ideal for those working in schools, recreation and community centres and is also suitable for those who want to support friends or loved ones and learn how to respond in an opioid poisoning situation. Topics include basics of opioids, identifying an opioid poisoning, assessment and care for a suspected opioid poisoning.

Designed to build participant confidence in performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) skills and provide the important steps to perform a rapid assessment, perform Basic Life Support (BLS) skills, and perform rapid defibrillation. Airway Management and Oxygen Therapy are also added as additional certifications to this course. This program is designed for infacility and health care providers (nursing, care aides, dental industry, medical offices etc.), pre-hospital care groups (fire departments, rescue teams, sports therapists, lifeguards, SCUBA divers, ski patrol, etc.). BECOME A LIFEGUARD!

We are looking for energetic, positive people who want to help make a difference. The National Lifeguard (NL) award builds on the skill, knowledge and values that the Lifesaving Society teaches in its pre-Bronze and Bronze Medal awards to develop the practical skills and knowledge required by lifeguards.

STEP 1 | BRONZE MEDALLION | Ages 13yrs+

Bronze Medallion, as our flagship certification, teaches an understanding of the lifesaving principles embodied in the four components of water rescue education - judgement, knowledge, skill and fitness. Bronze Medallion challenges the candidate both mentally and physically. Candidates acquire the assessment and problem-solving skills needed to make good decisions in, on and around the water. Bronze Medallion is a pre-requisite for assistant lifeguard training in Bronze Cross. Lifesaving Manual \$55.00

STEP 2 | BRONZE CROSS | Ages 13yrs+

The Lifesaving Society's Bronze Cross begins the transition from lifesaving to lifeguarding and prepares candidates for responsibilities as assistant lifeguards. Candidates strengthen and expand their lifesaving skills and begin to apply the principles and techniques of active surveillance in aquatic facilities. Bronze Cross emphasizes the importance of teamwork and communication in preventing and responding to aquatic emergencies. Bronze Cross is a pre-requisite for advanced training in the Society's National Lifeguard and leadership certification programs.

STEP 4 | NATIONAL LIFEGUARD | Ages 15yrs+

This 8-day course builds on the fundamental skills, knowledge and values taught in the Lifesaving Awards to develop the practical skills and knowledge required by lifeguards. NL education develops a sound understanding of lifeguarding principles, good judgment, and a mature and responsible attitude toward the role of the lifeguard. Candidates must show proof on the first day of Bronze Cross and Standard First Aid or equivalent. This course also certifies candidates in Airway Management and Oxygen Administration (AMOA).

YOU CAN EARN HIGH SCHOOL CREDITS IN OUR LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS



British Columbia and Yukon high school students can use Lifesaving Society certifications for credit toward high school graduation as follows:

- Bronze Cross is worth 2 credits for Grade 11
- Bronze Cross and Lifesaving Instructor (LSI) are worth 3 credits for Grade 11
- National Lifeguard Pool option (NL) is worth 2 credits for Grade 12

Students may only use these credits for the assigned grades (i.e. students cannot combine both certifications towards one grade) The awards do not need to be current.
