

APPROVED TRACTION CONTROL

Sand provided by the City (Red bins) this sand is provided as a courtesy but should not be relied on as your only source of traction.

- Parking Lot at corner of Barlow and Mclean (Willis Harper)
- City Parking Lot at corner of Reid and St. Laurent Avenue (Spirit Square),
- City Parking Lot at corner of Kinchant & Barlow (Legion).

Mixture of Sand and Salt (>1%)

• DO NOT use more than 1% salt on the sidewalks. This will cause extreme erosion and damage the sidewalk.

Lava Grip

- Great alternative to sand. This product is not effected by temperature, does not track into businesses and is easy to clear in the spring.
