Utility bill due dates

Annual utility bills for water, sewer and garbage charges are mailed out in early February

Pay the entire bill by March 13, 2020 and receive a 10% discount. If you prefer to pay quarterly, receive a 5% discount when payments are made by the following due dates:

March 13, 2020

May 8, 2020

August 14, 2020

November 13, 2020

Paying your utility bill

There are five ways you can pay your utility bill. Find your 13 digit account/customer number on your bill.

CREDIT CARDS ARE NOT ACCEPTED

- **1. Online banking** at participating financial institutions. Do not include the first three digits from your account number.
- **2. Telephone** at participating financial institutions.
- 3. By mail 410 Kinchant St, Quesnel, BC, V2J 7J5.
- **4. In-person** at City Hall by cash, cheque or debit card. Monday to Friday, 8:30 am 4:30 pm excluding holidays.
- **5. After hours** drop cheques in the drop box at City Hall (located on the side of the front entrance).

TELEPHONE/ONLINE BANKING Allow 2-3 business days processing time to ensure your payment is applied by the due date. Please note your utility account number at the time of payment to avoid payments being applied to the wrong account. A \$25 service fee will be applied for transferring the funds to another utility or a property tax account.

SOUTH QUESNEL RESIDENTS: Please note that the Cariboo Regional District will send you an invoice for your sewer charges. Apply your sewer service payment directly to the Cariboo Regional District as it is separate from the City of Quesnel. Please pay the enclosed utility invoice to the City of Quesnel.
